



Door Window and Screen Enquiry Guidelines

To enable us to provide an accurate quotation quickly for you, it would help if you could provide some information for us, it doesn't matter if there are things you are unsure of at this stage as we are happy to discuss all aspects with you as your enquiry develops.

In the following pages, you will find design examples, possible layouts and how they can come together, ideally if you can select a style, it gives us a good starting point for a quotation, next it would help us if you can give an indication of overall dimensions of each aperture and a sketch or choose a layout, then we can produce a balanced layout for you.

If you can provide answers to any of the remaining questions that would greatly assist us in providing the quotation in greater detail as well as helping yourself to understand the various options and considerations.

If you do not see what you require or have your own specific design or requirements then that is not a problem, we are happy to assist and discuss everything with you. Everything we make is made to your specific requirements.

We actively encourage our clients to come to our showroom and design suite, though not essential it does help that you see exact samples of your selections and to discuss in details various options available.

If you could return the enquiry form by email, fax or post, then in most circumstances we can provide a quotation within 24 hours of receipt.

Our Process

Once a quotation has been accepted and an order placed, if requested our surveyor will visit site to take exact dimensions. The project is then passed to the drawing office who will produce manufacturing drawings for your approval. It is important that at this stage that final selection of design, colour and furniture is made, as changes after this stage could incur additional costs and delays in manufacture/completion dates.

Once your approval is given, the project is passed from the sales office to a dedicated project manager who will confirm a completion date and will be your main point of contact through to the end of the project.

A couple of weeks or more before completion of manufacture the project manager will contact you to organise a specific date/time for delivery or installation if selected.

Final Options

Our quotation will have included unless otherwise specified, our standard furniture package and finishes, also included is a standard paint colour finish, however there are additional options for different furniture finishes and specialised paint finishes. By the time of your approval of drawings your final selections need to be made

Lead Times

Upon receiving an enquiry, we are happy to give a current lead time based on our current commitments but we generally cannot give exact completion date until final approval of drawing and option selections are received. There are circumstances where we can confirm an exact delivery date before selections are made but there are requirements of certain dates that need to be met for drawing approval and selections.

As everything we do is made specifically for you, we cannot start production until selections and approval have been made.

Lead times can vary from 8 weeks to 18 weeks, dependant on time of year and size on project, lead times are more constrained if selections and drawing approval are given quickly and standard options and designs are selected.

To avoid disappointment, place your order as early as possible in your project planning.

Installation/survey

Survey: once an order is placed our surveyor if chosen will come and measure the site and discuss requirements of the works with you or your builder, the measurements will enable us to produce manufacturing drawings for your approval. It should be noted however that responsibility lies with the client to check that drawings and dimensions are correct and fit the apertures, particular attention should be made to finished floor heights. This is because many projects are in conjunction with other trades on a site which we have no control and sites can often change between survey and completion.

Installation: Our installation teams are fully employed by us, we do not use sub-contractors like many of our competitors, your quotation will include an optional cost for installation if requested.

Installation of our product is not difficult for a competent tradesman if they follow our guidelines but our warranty only then extends to the manufactured goods.

It should be noted however that the application of the silicone glazing is a skilled trade and we can offer that as a separate service to those wishing to organise their own installation but not tackle the silicone.

Working with builders

Many of our projects we work alongside/in conjunction with our client's builders, it is useful to have discussions early in the project of the certain requirements of the builder in any associated building work, for example the tolerances on apertures for steel windows needs to be more exact than say UPVC products as the nature of the slim perimeter frames means than cover plates and infill packs are not desired, whereas on UPVC products it is common place to use these to cover large gaps. It is far more important that apertures are finished to the correct size and are square/parallel on steel windows and doors as there is little to no adjustment once manufactured.

Finished floor heights seem to be the biggest area of concern/difficulty, it is very important that a finished floor height is agreed at survey and not changed thereafter.
